

## **NEWSLETTER**





## **MOUSE TOOLTIP TRANSLATOR**

When looking at China OSINT it is inevitable that we come across Chinese language. It can be difficult to get translate on some web-pages. We have found that Mouse Tooltip Translator helps with big pages of text. It is a Chrome extension designed to provide simplified translation by allowing users to translate text instantly by hovering the mouse over a word or letter. The extension utilizes Google Translate and Google Text-to-Speech services for its functionality but also has options for other translation tools. As it is a Chrome extension, it can only be used on a Google Chrome browser. The Chinese translation is accurate enough to get a sense of what a character or sentence means. It would be wise to pair this tool with other translation tools for a better understanding. It's a free tool so it's worth trying out.
